
# Arizona Policy Lab Election & Policy Survey, Fall 2020

The Arizona Policy Lab Election & Policy Survey was collected by Dynata/SSI from September 1 - September 9, 2020. A total of 1,144 residents of Arizona completed this survey; 1,000 respondents were contacted by email and 144 respondents were contacted by telephone. We weight the data to state population proportions, with respect to age, sex, Hispanic ethnicity, income, and race; gender and age were imputed for phone respondents using multiple imputation through chained equations (MICE). Respondents had the option to complete the survey in English or Spanish.



Perceptions AZ Dem Party




Would you say that Republicans in Arizona are more conservative, more

liberal, or about the same as the national Republican Party?


## Perceptions AZ Rep Party


Do you approve or disapprove of the construction of a Border Wall along the US-Mexico border?


To what extent do you support or oppose a pathway to citizenship for immigrants who entered the United States illegally as children, a group commonly known as the Dreamers?


Generally speaking, do you think that immigrants who move to Arizona help the economy of the state, hurt the economy of the state, or make no difference?




Immigrants Help/Hurt AZ




When you go out in public, how often do you wear a face mask?






Do you believe that face-masks should be required by law when Arizonans are out in public?






Presidential Vote



Which candidate for Senate do you support in the 2020 Election?


